



COLONOSCOPY PREP INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARATION BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

PURCHASE 1 (ONE) BI-PEGLYTE BOWEL PREPARATION KIT AND CLEAR FLUIDS.

• Each kit contains 2 (two) packets of PEGLYTE and 1 blister pack of 3 (three) Bisacodyl tablets.

1 WEEK BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

*Stop any medications containing acetylsalicylic acid (Aspirin) or NSAIDs [e.g., ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin), naproxen (Naprosyn), rofecoxib (Vioxx), celecoxib (Celebrex), etc.] as the risk of bleeding with these medications is higher.

IF YOU ARE TAKING BLOOD THINNERS, NOTIFY OUR OFFICE IMMEDIATELY.

*Stop any iron supplements (e.g., multivitamins with iron or iron tablets).

*4 days before your procedure, stop any foods containing seeds.

THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

- 1. TAKE ALL 3 BISACODYL TABLETS FIRST THING IN THE MORNING.
- 2. NO SOLID FOOD ALLOWED. NO MILK OR DAIRY PRODUCTS ALLOWED.
 - a. **Drink plenty of clear fluids throughout the day the more, the better.**
 - Allowed: water, apple juice, white cranberry juice, pulp-free orange juice or lemonade, consommé or bouillon, Jello, coffee, tea, Gatorade, soda, and popsicles (MUST NOT CONTAIN RED, BLUE, OR PURPLE COLOURS).
 - c. Do not drink only water. Your body needs calories.

7:00PM THE NIGHT BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

ADD THE *FIRST* PACKET OF PEGLYTE TO 2 LITRES OF WATER. STIR AND DRINK 2 LITRES OF THE PEGLYTE SOLUTION OVER 2 HOURS AND AT LEAST ONE GLASS OF CLEAR FLUID EVERY HOUR AS LONG AS YOU FEEL THE EFFECTS. YOU MAY TAKE GRAVOL IF YOU FEEL NAUSEATED.

4 HOURS BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

ADD THE SECOND PACKET OF PEGLYTE TO 2 LITRES OF WATER. STIR AND DRINK 2 LITRES OF THE PEGLYTE SOLUTION OVER 2 HOURS. YOU MAY CONTINUE TO DRINK CLEAR FLUIDS UP TO THE TIME YOU LEAVE FOR THE HOSPITAL.

CHECK IN 1 HOUR BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

Sedation will be given at the hospital. You must arrange for a ride home.

Expect to be at the hospital for approximately 2 hours in total. You will not be allowed to leave the hospital without a responsible person to stay with you for 24 hours after the procedure.
